

# Phases of the Moon Pocket

Print the pocket and fold in tabs. Glue or tape tabs to the back half of the pocket.  
Place moon cards in pocket.

## Activities for moon cards

Younger children:

Memory/concentration game. Turn cards with moon phase face down and have child turn two cards over, if they match they keep that set. Continue until all are matched. Name the card each time they turn it over until they become familiar and name the card themselves.

Explain to them why the moon is important to Muslims in Ramadan.

Elementary age children:

Discuss the different phases. Make out a calendar of 30 days. Explain what phase of the moon we look for and look up the moon phases on the internet and have child place the moon phase cards on their calendar.

Make a Moon phase weekly chart. Take a piece of paper and draw two squares and have child place the moon card. You can have your child decorate the chart to his/her liking

Of the current phase. Put Velcro on the back of laminated cards so they will be reusable.
