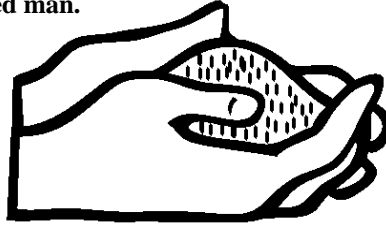


zakaat math

how do we measure a saa'

One saa' consists of four amdadd (plural of mudd). A Mudd is equal to one handful using two hands cupped together of an average sized man.



Explain the measurement of a saa' to your child to help them understand.

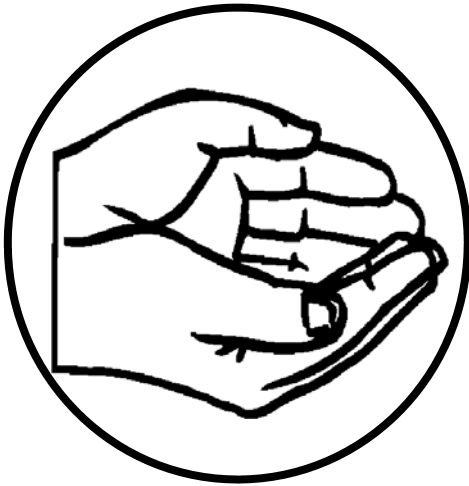
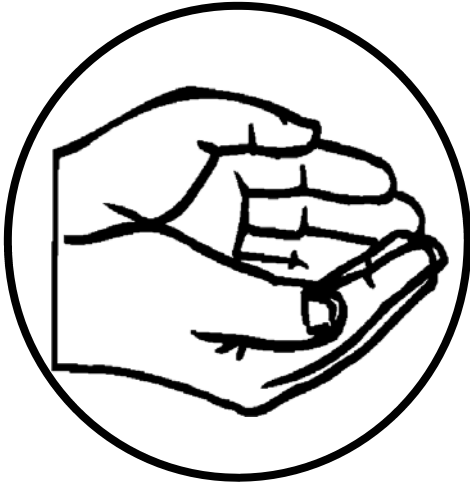
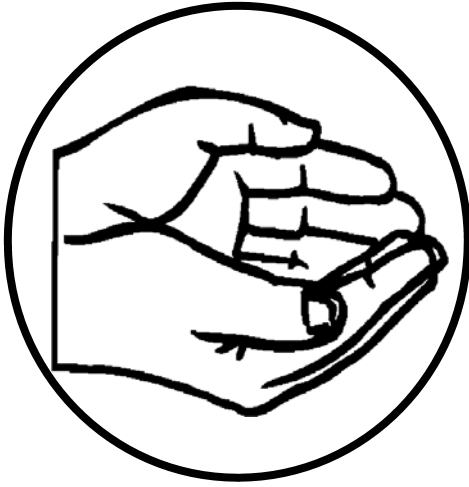
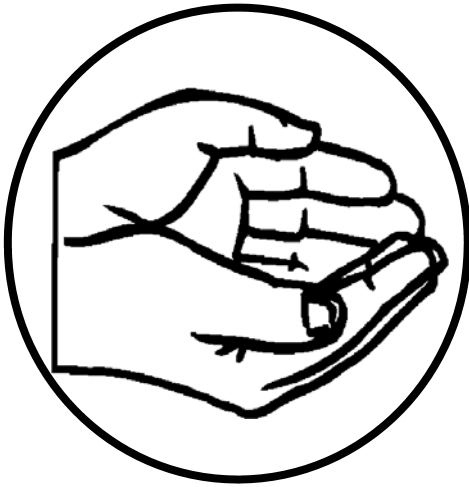
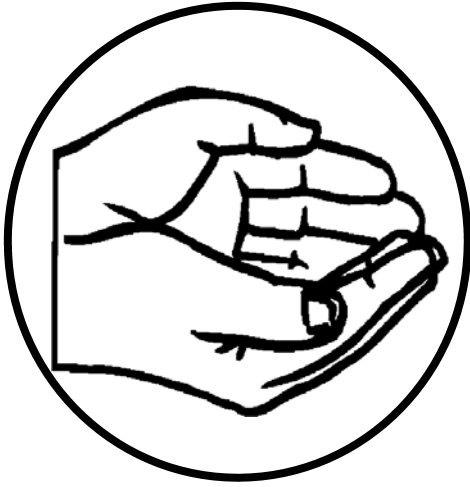
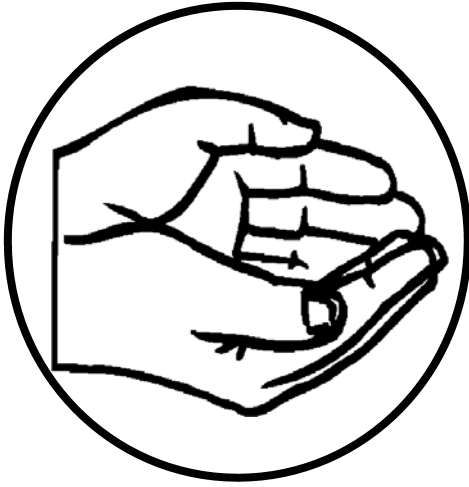
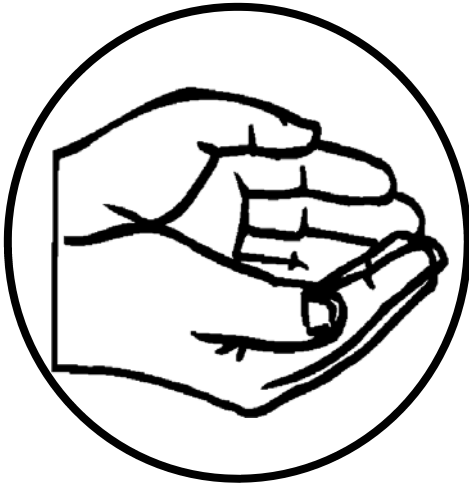
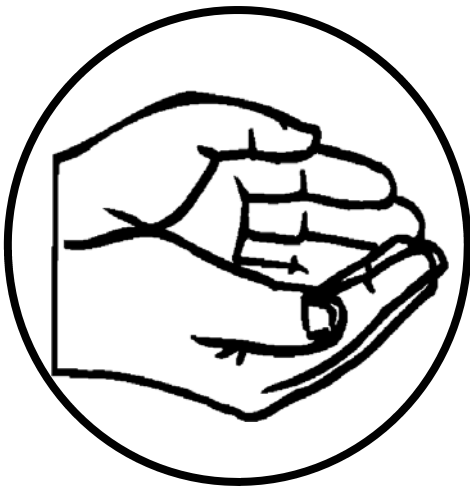
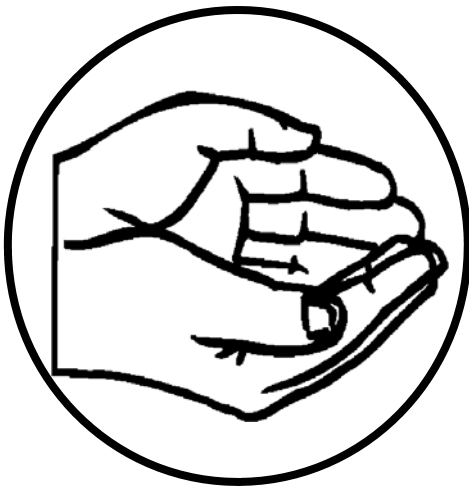
Ask your child questions like:
